More solar power for Mam Rashaan

Good news from Iraq: atmosfair is expanding the solar power supply for the camp for refugees in Mam Rashaan, which we set up last year together with the state of Baden-Württemberg. The original photovoltaic system with a capacity of 380kWp could only cover 20 percent of the day's electricity demand in the camp - a good start, but not yet satisfactory. In September, work started on the second construction phase. In doing so, we are increasing the capacity by 600kWp to a total of almost 1MWp, thereby significantly improving the energy supply in the camp. We are also expanding the storage system and rebuilding the distribution network so that we can cover the energy requirements during the day in the best possible way.
