After the start of local production of our "Save 80" stove at the beginning of the year, things have been developing very encouragingly.

The work processes are well coordinated, so that the "Safer 1" team led by production manager Joseph Nsabimana can currently complete around 100 stoves per day. This is about half of the targeted capacity and extremely gratifying, especially since the machinery is not yet complete (e.g., a bigger air compressor is to be installed soon) and the team size is still being built up.
