In addition, by using the stove also less smoke is produced compared to conventional stoves or three stone fire. Thus, the stoves do not only save CO₂, but also improve health and help against the decline of forests in Rwanda by saving wood.

After the great success of the last years, it is clear that we want to continue. Therefore, together with our partner Safer Rwanda, we have built a new stove factory in Kigali, where our stoves are produced entirely locally since March of this year. This will enable even more

users to benefit from our efficient stoves in the future.
