A.2. A non-technical summary of the project

>>

This project aims to introduce electric cooking as a clean and affordable alternative to traditional wood and charcoal cooking in Madagascar. As part of a broader rural electrification effort, atmosfair is supporting the establishment of solar-powered mini-grids in collaboration with the project developer Anka all over Madagascar. Within those Mini-Grids Anka wants to offer electric cooking opportunities to the households. To make electric cooking accessible to households, atmosfair will subsidize electricity costs, ensuring it is a cost-effective option compared to traditional fuels. This initiative not only improves indoor air quality and reduces deforestation but also provides households with a modern and convenient way to cook. The financial support for the project will partially come from carbon credits, with registration under the Gold Standard currently in progress.

The electric cooking devices will be purchased by the households or in the case they can't afford it donated by a third party, ensuring that households have access to appropriate and efficient appliances.

Transitioning to electric cooking offers multiple benefits. Environmentally, it significantly reduces CO₂ emissions by decreasing reliance on woody biomass and fossil fuels. Socially, it improves indoor air quality, thereby reducing health risks such as respiratory problems and eye infections associated with smoke exposure.

Economically, it alleviates the financial burden on users by lowering fuel costs and reducing the time spent collecting firewood.

atmosfair and Anka run a pilot project to have a test phase, in which we tested the amount of required subsidy, different cooking devices and collected user feedback. Based on that results the project has been developed. The pilot project with ca. 40 households was not registered as a carbon project. Many of the stakeholders participated in the local stakeholder consultation have been part of the pilot phase, cause they are most interested in the roll out of the project.

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1. Agenda & Introduction

Agenda:

Note from PD: Many of the stakeholders participated in the workshop have been part of the pilot phase, so therefore they knew the benefits of the e-cooking already and some of the comments are related to the pilot phase or the bridge between end of the pilot phase and start of the carbon project.

2. Testimonials from users participating at the pilot phase

At the beginning of the session when each participant introduced himself, some of the participant that were part of the pilot phase gave a feedback on the pilot phase.

- **Mrs. Natacha:** "I'm pleased with the e-cooking kit because my hands are cleaner, I can use the kettle, and cooking food is quicker."
- **Mme Espérance:** "I'm satisfied with the use of the e-cooking kit, even if the costs are still quite high."

- **Emile:** "You need to raise awareness more because people don't know how to use equipment properly. In my case, I've never had any major problems with my previous equipment."
- **General feedback:** The rice cooker was liked for convenience (e.g., warm food in the evening), but had poor quality and needed replacement multiple times.

3. Project and Product Information introduced by Raissa and Nele

- **Change of equipment:** We're not going to be distributing rice cookers any more because we've seen that the product wears out easily in the conditions here, so we've opted for an induction solution because we think it's more suitable and the product has already been tested and applied in other African countries. The new solution is an induction cooker (2 pots, 1 frying pan), which is more robust, comes with a warranty, and has been tested in other African countries. As an example we demonstrated the BURN equipment but mentioned that the manufacturer can change based on availability and experiences.
- **BURN's intervention zone:** Africa.
- **Subsidy:** The equipment is subsidized; users pay only a maintenance and training fee, not the full purchase price at the beginning of the project. Subsidy for around 4000 stoves assured. The electricity price will be subsidized by atmosfair and will be higher than in the pilot phase. There will be two steps of subsidy. A higher one for the first two years and then a little bit reduced one for the following 3 years. After 5 years of usage it will be evaluated if an ongoing of the subsidy is required to make the ecooking affordable compared to cooking with firewood or charcoal. The subsidy of the electricity price is enabled through the registration of the project under the Gold Standard mechanism. The households are transferring the right to claim the emission reductions to atmosfair in return of getting the subsidies of the electricity. This will be clarified in the user contracts. The
- **Target group:** Around 500 households per village; interested households can register until the quota is reached, others will be waitlisted.
- **Ownership:** The equipment is intended for use only in in the Anka Mini-grids so e.g. Anakao/Mangily and should not be relocated or sold elsewhere (e.g., to Tuléar).

4. Questions and Answers (by name where given)

After the introduction of the project, the demonstration of the new technology that will be used and the demonstration of the improvements compared to the pilot phase the participants were able to raise questions.

Q&A in Anakao:

Mme Cérise

- **Q:** "Are you sure that this new product is more solid/robust than the previous one?"

A (Raïssa): The new product is under guarantee, already tested and validated in various African countries.

Chief FKT Anakao Bas

- **Q:** "ANKA had promised that the more customers connected to the grid, the cheaper the electricity would be, whereas the opposite is true at present."

A (Raïssa): ANKA has made no such promise. As we have to maintain the power station, ANKA is obliged to increase the tariff. Yes, ANKA is more expensive than JIRAMA (PD add: the national grid operator highly subsidized by the government), but ANKA's tariff is cheaper than that of its competitors. (PD comment: cause Anka is getting support by atmosfair for the financing of the Mini-Grids) And for the Ecooking the electricity price will be further subsidized.

Lahiniriko (1st Deputy)

- **Q:** "For the previous kits in the pilot phase, some people haven't even finished paying their contribution for the kit and the kits have already been damaged. What guarantees do we have that this won't be the case with this new product? What steps need to be taken to become one of the new beneficiaries?"

A (Raïssa): The new product is more robust and comes with a warranty. After the project starts, there will be an awareness campaign and explanation of beneficiary conditions. You can apply as a beneficiary as explained earlier. But your household needs to be within one of our Mini-Grids, E.g. kits are not to be used outside Anakao.

François

- **Q:** "What happens if the customer moves house and takes his kit with him?"
A (Raïssa): Trackers are installed; kits are intended for Anakao only. Relocations are exceptional cases.
- **Q:** "Does this mean that ANKA has to give out new meters with each induction kit, because if customers plug them in directly to their main meter we won't be able to record e-cooking consumption directly, and how will we allocate the

bonuses in that case?"

A (Raïssa): This is a very pertinent question. We are still working with our partners and supplier to find the best way of tracking bonuses. Updates will follow.

Emile

- **Q:** "What happens if people take their kits elsewhere? What are the penalties?"

A (Raïssa): Kits are for Anakao only and should not be sold. We are working with Burn and other manufacturers on a way to block induction if it is taken out of the destination zone.

- **Q:** "What happens with the other kits when we move house, do we still get a new meter?"

A (Raïssa): If you move and are a former user, you are still entitled to a dedicated meter for e-cooking. If you buy your own rice cooker, you will benefit from the bonus, but only ANKA technicians can install new equipment.

- **Q:** "Will other equipment be coming along, or just induction?"

A (Raïssa): For now, only induction cookers are approved. Please let us know your needs for consideration.

Pasteur

- **Q:** "Are there bigger pots?"

A (Raïssa): Only standard sizes are provided (2 pots, 1 frying pan). You can buy your own pots if they are induction-compatible and fit the induction circle.

Beneficiary (unnamed)

- **Q:** "Can ANKA pay for the repair of old defective equipment?"

A (Raïssa): No, ANKA no longer repairs old kits.

Q&A in Mangily:

Lahaniriko

- **Q:** "Are the new e-cooking kits really adapted to our food cooking needs?"

A (Raïssa): Yes, the new kits are adapted to your needs. They allow for cooking various types of food, and each household will receive three cooking pots specifically designed for this kit. It functions similarly to the induction cookware available on the market.

Josiane

- **Q:** "When an appliance breaks down, we send it abroad (Africa) for repair. But it takes time, so we go back to using charcoal in the meantime."

A (Raïssa): First if there is any issue with the kit, you should report it immediately to ANKA team, at the sale's point sale or by calling. That allows us to diagnose the problem quickly. If a return is needed, we will arrange to send back the kit for repair. Burn, our partner, guarantees the equipment, so we advise not to tamper with the kits yourself, as it could void the warranty. We are doing our best to minimize the time needed for repairs.

Lahaniriko

- **Q:** "I was happy there was no rental fee for the meter. Will this continue? And do we receive a new meter for the new kit?"

A (Raïssa): No, you don't need a new meter with the new kits. The existing meter remains compatible. As explained, ANKA will cover the e-cooking kit cost. A small contribution will be required for the e-cooking kits themselves, and more details on this will be shared soon.

Tovonance

- **Q:** "Will ANKA only offer this type of kit, or are there plans to offer other equipment as well? For example, PUE (Productive use of Energy equipment that can help the beneficiaries to increase their income?"

A (Raïssa): For e-cooking, we have presented the kits to be distributed next year. Regarding income-generating appliances (productive uses), ANKA is still looking for funding to support beneficiaries in that area. For the e-cooking, the subsidy model has also evolved: instead of percentage-based discounts on day and base consumption, we will now apply a fixed subsidy of €0.11/kWh.

- **Q:** "I moved to a different house far away, and my meter remained at the old place. What can I do? I can't afford a new connection, and my kit doesn't work now."

A (Raïssa): Unfortunately, connection costs are not covered by ANKA. ANKA is responsible for distributing the e-cooking kits and applying the electricity subsidy, but not for connection fees. Normally, only already-connected customers are eligible for the e-cooking kits. Since you've moved and are no longer connected, you're no longer eligible for the program at this time.

Elizabeth

- **Q:** "There are both old and new meters. How can we connect the kits to these different types? And what about the bonuses/subsidies?"

A (Raïssa): As mentioned, you do not need a new meter. The old meters remain compatible with the new kits.

A (Nele): Regarding the bonuses/subsidy, Atmosfair is willing to continue the subsidy for your currently used equipment. So, you can still benefit from the bonuses while waiting for the new kits and the new subsidy model.

Odette

- **Q:** “What should we do with the old meters? Should we keep them?”

A (Raïssa and Sarah): As mentioned, for now you should keep the old meters because they will still be needed with the new kits. As Ms. Nele said, the subsidy program is resuming, so keeping the meters ensures the continuity of support.

5. Additional Questions and Answers

Those questions were raised within discussions during the LSC and within the lunch break etc. It was not a question of a specific person so the names were not tracked.

- **Can we keep the sparkmeter from the pilot?**

Spark meters were provided for monitoring and are not household property. If new equipment has integrated meters, spark meters may be collected by ANKA.

- **How are the contract conditions?**

Users receive the equipment and pay a maintenance fee. Electricity is provided at a subsidized rate. In return, atmosfair receives rights to emission reductions. Full contract details will be provided later.

- **Can we have a cover for the pan?**

Currently, the manufacturer does not offer it, but this will be checked.

- **Is traditional rice cooking (with burning at the bottom) possible with the new system?**

This question will be forwarded to BURN, the manufacturer.

- **I moved to a new house not connected to the grid. Can I still benefit from the project?**

No, only grid-connected households can participate. New connections require a new pole, which can be shared among interested households.

- **Is there a health risk due to the e-cooking equipment?**

No, and more detailed information will be provided during user training.

- **What happens if the material has some issues? What is the response time?**

The manufacturer will have local presence for operation and maintenance; exact response time will be clarified in training.

- **Will there be other programmes to support productive use?**

There are talks about it, but details are not finalized. Subsidies from atmosfair require direct CO2 emission reduction. Likely, there will be loans rather than donations.

- **How do we select the beneficiaries?**

The project will be announced, and interested households can register until the quota (around 500) is reached. The rest will wait for a project extension.

- **How is metering happening without an extra sparkmeter?**

The technical setup is being discussed with Burn and other manufacturers. Users will receive a monthly bonus for e-cooking used the previous month.

6. Price and Cost Comparisons

As the eCooking costs were several times an issue raised a comparison with charcoal cooking was made. It turns out that some households are paying much less for charcoal than Anka identified in their study and such those households are experiencing the eCooking more expensive.

- **Charcoal:** 5,000 Ariary per bag; 1–2 bags per month depending on family size.
- **eCooking:** 2,000–3,000 Ariary per day without subsidy; 1,000–1,700 Ariary per day with subsidy. Still higher than charcoal, but users appreciate the convenience and cleanliness. And see that the charcoal prices are increasing.

7. Social, Economic & Environmental Impacts (SDG Exercise)

The SDG exercise was done by presenting the SDG and explaining it a little bit and then asking the stakeholders if they are seeing an impact of the project to the SDG and how this impact could be measured. Filling meanwhile out the table together.

8. Safeguarding Principles

The safeguarding principles were also presented and explained to the stakeholders. It were asked if they see any risks and the following aspects were raised:

1. Security for kids when they are using the ecooking device, is it safe?

Answer: Burn and also other manufacturers when they are selected have done quality and safety checks on the system and we will give the manual and a training to the customers.

2. What about health? Can there be bad effects through the induction stove?

Answer: Those things have been checked by the manufacturer before bringing the product onto the market and to be able to sale it on the market.

3. What happens when the subsidy is over after 5 years?

Answer: Then we will do a new survey to see if a subsidy is still required or if the ecooking costs are the same as charcoal costs already.

9. Open Issues & Next Steps

As the closing of the session Raissa and Nele explained the next steps and the time plan for the project.

- Final subsidy amounts for equipment and electricity will be communicated once confirmed. Meanwhile for the people within the pilot project the old subsidy will be continued.
- Technical details for metering and bonus distribution are being finalized.
- Further awareness campaigns and user training sessions will be organized.
- Exploration of additional equipment and productive use programs will continue.
- Manufacturer (e.g.BURN) will clarify certain technical and usage questions
- The plan is to start in May 2025 with the awareness campaigns and in June with the distribution of the eCooking devices. But there might be changes/delays depending on the negotiations with the manufacturer regarding the metering.
