An example of good partnership

Tudor WaterKiosk is a great example of local and international partnership. The WaterKiosk is installed at the Pastoral Center, Catholic Archdiocese of Mombasa where a 45kW off-grid solar plant is powering the entire

compound. The WaterKiosk dispension station is directed to the public road. The security, land and services offered by the center facilitates the smooth operation of the system, and easies the project integration with the locals. Tudor WaterKiosk, powered by a 9kW solar power plant is delivering up to 20,000 liter of hygiene drinking water per day to the locals at the most affordable cost.
